- ✓ Includes all of the Maine Oral Health Risk Assessment questions. Nutritional questions are part of the Let's Go! healthy weight initiative
- ✓ Includes fluoride varnish applied and captures if patient or family declines in the drop down menu
- ✓ Includes if fluoride supplements were prescribed or not indicated
- ✓ Includes referral to a dentist
- ✓ Includes oral health plan and notes for additional documentation

Section A : Oral Health Risk

Does the child have teeth ? No -- STOP & Reassess at next visit

Has child seen a Dentist in the past year ? If yes stop here

Does child have his/her teeth brushed daily with toothpast ?

Has the child ever had cavities or fillings ?

Has the Mother/Primary caregiver had active/untreated cavities in the past year ?

SECTION B : Oral Evaluation and Plan

Must be performed by Primary care Provider

Q6. Is there visable plaque on the teeth ? Yes -- This is a Risk Factor

Q7. Are there signs of visable decay or white spot lesions on the teeth ?

Q8. Does the child have other conditions of concern (abscess, broken tooth, pain, ect...)?

Consider Florida Varnish for one or more Risk Factors from Section A and/or B.

Oral Health Plan

Must be Performed or Delegated by Primary Care Provider

Oral Health Plan

1. Applied Fluoride Varnish if moderate/high risk (Med Admin)
2. Completed Caries Risk Assessment w/ Oral Evaluation
3. Fluoride Supplements not indicated
4. Prescribed Fluoride Supplement (Rx)
